Nominations will be sent by e-mail (to : anne-tifenn.gargam@ac-rennes.fr) The nomination must include the following information about the candidate: first and last name, e-mail address, field of study, period of mobility (semester(s) or academic year). The applicant will be contacted by the teacher responsible for the bachelor's degree, who will inform him/her of the documents the teaching team needs to examine the applications:
		 — A short letter explaining reasons for choosing DNMADE and HEI BREQUIGNY. — A digital portfolio (presenting personal work that must include graphic design creations).

- Minimum of 3 graphic design projects on a variety of media demonstrating the use of technical software (DTP and/or web and/or 3D). e.g. poster, publishing, visual identity, motion, website, typography, etc.
- Minimum of 2 projects demonstrating an interest in visual arts. e.g. painting, photography, engraving, drawing, etc.
