Nomination	2	The official nomination of candidates will be sent by the ERASMUS coordinator of the sending-institution about the candidate to the ERASMUS and the PEDAGOGICAL coordinators of the receiving-institution (HEI Bréquigny). The nomination must include the following information about the candidate: first and last name, e-mail address, field of study, period of mobility (semester(s) or academic year). Application	3	Nominated students will have to provide to the Master Design DSAA coordinator of the receiving-institution: • Official nomination from your Institute; • A short letter explaining reasons for choosing the DSAA program and HEI BREQUIGNY; • A digital portfolio with samples of course related works (PDF file or link to an online portfolio).

Please note that admission criteria mostly base on the artistic quality of a portfolio and the HEI Bréquigny reserves the right to accept a limited amount of applicants.

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| 4 | A twenty-minute interview may be organized between the candidate and master DSAA teachers to discuss motivations, interest in the course program, specializations, English language skills and settling in France. |
| 5 | Confirmation of the candidate's final acceptance will be sent by HEI Bréquigny. |

Language of study	FRENCH — The main language of instruction is French. Individuals talks in english may be possibles during design projects and courses. There is also elective courses for exchange students, which are taught entirely in English. We strongly advises Erasmus+ students to take french courses before coming.

Attendance	Attendance to lessons is mandatory of every single course.

Insurance	All Erasmus students must provide medical, accident and travel insurance for themselves. Insurance should include the cost of repatriation (assisted transfer of a person back to their home country in case of serious injury or illness). The insurance has to cover the entire period of stay at HEI bréquigny. Incoming students should e-mail a copy of their insurance doc to the Exchange Coordinator, before their mobility period.
National Health Insurance Card	EU students should also hold a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC card).
Bank account	It is necessary, e.g., to register your name in a lease, to open an account or to sign contracts with utility companies. You just need to open a bank account compatible to european transfer (IBAN with BIC).
Local transport / Korrigo card	EU students should also hold a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC card). A korrigo card is required to enter and leave the school. Create your Korrigo card.
Accomodation	Please remind that the HEI Bréquigny doesn't offer accommodation, so it's highly recommended to start looking for a place as soon as possible.
