| | 2 | The applicant will be contacted by the teacher responsible for the bachelor's degree, who will inform him/her of the documents the teaching team needs to examine the applications: — A short letter explaining reasons for choosing DNMADE and HEI BREQUIGNY. — A digital portfolio (presenting personal work that must include graphic design creations). Selection criteria portfolio: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum of 3 graphic design projects on a variety of media demonstrating the use of technical software (DTP and/or web and/or 3D). e.g. poster, publishing, visual identity, motion, website, typography, etc. • Minimum of 2 projects demonstrating an interest in visual arts. e.g. painting, photography, engraving, drawing, etc. • Technical skills |

- 3 A twenty-minute interview may be organized between the candidate and DNMADE teachers to discuss motivations, interest in the course program, specializations, French language skills and settling in France.
- 4 Confirmation of the candidate's final acceptance will be sent by HEI Bréquigny.
- 5 The sending-institution sends the completed and signed OLA form to the receiving-institution (HEI Bréquigny) and informs the HEI Bréquigny's ERASMUS coordinator that the document has been signed by the student and the sending-institution.

Insurance should include the cost of repatriation (assisted transfer of a person back to their home country in case of serious injury or illness). The insurance has to cover the entire period of stay at HEI bréquigny. Incoming students should e-mail a copy of their insurance doc to the Exchange Coordinator, before their mobility period. |
| National Health Insurance Card | EU students should also hold a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC card). |
| Bank account | It is necessary, e.g., to register your name in a lease, to open an account or to sign contracts with utility companies. You just need to open a bank account compatible to european transfer (IBAN with BIC). |
